FOR FILLIES AND MARES THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$150 each, which should accompany the nomination; \$750 to pass the entry box, \$750 to start. The NYRA purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among remaining finishers. Breeders' Cup Fund monies also correspondingly divided. Any Breeders' Cup Fund monies not awarded will revert back to the Fund. Three year olds, 118 lbs.; Older 122 lbs. Non-winners of a Grade 1 in 2006 or a Grade 2 twice in 2006 allowed 3 lbs.; a Grade 1 in 2005; or a Grade 2 in 2006, 5 lbs.; a Graded Sweepstake in 2005-06, 7 lbs. A trophy to the winning owner given by Breeders' Cup Ltd. The New York Racing Association will present trophies to the winning Trainer and Jockey. Closed Saturday, August 12, 2006 with 19 Nominations.



Footnotes

DUBAI ESCAPADE sprinted clear soon after the start, raced uncontested on the lead into the stretch then drew off to a lengthy score under a vigorous hand ride. NOTHING BUT FUN taken back in the early stages, was unhurried for a half while saving ground, launched a bid along the rail on the turn, altered course to the outside in upper stretch and closed late in the middle of the track to best the others. STORMY KISS (ARG) in hand early, chased along the rail for five furlongs, angled out in upper stretch and finished evenly. INDIAN FLARE prompted the pace in the two path into upper stretch and weakened. HIGH BUTTON SHOES saved ground to the turn and lacked the needed response when called upon. MALIBU MINT checked slightly along the backstretch, raced well back to the turn, drifted wide at the quarter pole and lacked a further response. GRECIAN LOVER raced in midpack for a half, swung four wide at the quarter pole and steadily tired thereafter.
