THATS A GOOD THING stumbled badly at the start, quickly recovered to race well placed just behind a contested pace while racing along the outside, moved readily when asked nearing the head of the stretch, entered the lane four wide, then finished with good energy to take charge leaving the furlong grounds and edge clear. FROSTY DIAMOND off to an alert beginning, quickly took the lead, was swung over to the inside approaching the turn, vied with a pair of rivals for the lead during the run around the turn, emerged in upper stretch with a clear advantage, proved no match for the top one during the final eighth but held well to garner place honors. RETRIEVER tracked the leader while taking the inside route, needed more during the stretch drive. CHEROKEE BULL argued the pace from the three path until upper stretch, weakened. SOLUTIONIST was no factor. LOCH DUBH contested the pace between rivals and gave way. LITTLE BIG HORN always inside, was outrun.
