Footnotes

HE'S LONG GONE pressed between horses for six furlongs, opened a clear advantage in upper stretch, maintained a clear lead into deep stretch and held off the runner-up under steady urging. TWISTED DREAM stumbled badly at the start, was outrun for a half, angled in midway on the turn, swung three wide entering the stretch then closed steadily but could not get up. LONGING FOR MALIBU checked between horses nearing the seven-eighths pole, saved ground to the turn and lacked a strong closing response. LOFTY BANNER steadied between horses entering the backstretch, raced just off the pace for five furlongs, split horses on the turn and lacked a further response. YANKEE CHIEF was outrun along the rail after breaking slowly. EL WINDO dueled along the rail inside the winner to the turn and gave way. MR. PETERSSON tucked in along the rail for five furlongs and lacked the needed response when called upon. ONE LUCKY DATE pressed three wide for five furlongs and faltered.
