BECKY'S KITTEN was rated in the middle of the pack while four wide, continued wide while gaining on the turn then closed steadily from outside to prevail after a long drive. BIGSHOT steadied in traffic entering the backstretch, raced well back for a half, followed the winner leaving the turn, circled five wide into the stretch and finished well in the middle of the track but could not get up. VAMOS A VER raced in traffic between horses for six furlongs, launched a rally along the inside entering the stretch and closed late in traffic to gain a share. KING ROCK pressed the pace from outside into upper stretch, gained a brief lead in midstretch and weakened late. WOW WOW WOW set the pace on the rail into midstretch and weakened. PANIOLLO checked at the start, was under a firm hold to the turn and lacked a strong closing bid while drifting out in the late stages. MINT MAKER trailed for most of the way after breaking slowly. ULTERIOR MOTIVE chased three wide to the turn and gave way. EL COMMODORE steadied while rank on the first through the opening half mile and faltered on the turn.
