Footnotes

STEALTH MISSILE sat patiently perched three wide off the front runners, was put to encouragement coming to the five-sixteenths pole, took off in earnest after being straightened away, by now being fully extended, poked a head in front upon hitting the eighth pole, then edged clear from that point under strong handling to the end. NOT FOR MONEY away well from the starting gate, tucked into the pocket soon after the start, tracked the leader from the inside under a good hold, was forced to remain on hold heading for the quarter pole, lacking sufficient racing clearance, entered the lane, still on hold and still caught behind traffic, altered course for freedom to the outside at the three-sixteenths pole, commenced to rally after being called upon, closed well down the middle of the track en route for the place. THE ZIPSTER prompted the pacesetter from the outside while being rated, was asked for a response turning for home, remained a prominent factor with an eighth to go, before being outkicked. TALL POPPI within range between rivals, had the rider lose the whip coming to the furlong marker, continued on willingly to grab the last major share. BILLY BEAR four wide around the turn, bumped lightly with MR. MADISON after settling into the lane, and had no serious stretch offering. MR. MADISON underwent a three wide pursuit, bumped lightly with BILLY BEAR in upper stretch, lacked the needed response after being called upon. SARATOGA SEVEN saved ground until the quarter pole. RISES THE PHOENIX saved ground and failed to menace. JUKE JOINT shot out of the gate to take the lead in a flash, cut the pace towards the inside while being well rated until the quarter

pole, offered resistance during the ensuing furlong, then gave way. HAILEYS HERO raced three wide and was outrun. GREAT EMPEROR offered little.
