SPANISH FORTUNE reluctant to load into the starting gate, proceeded to come away in good order, was guided out to the two path approaching the turn, took up chase on the loose leader, being lightly coaxed along, began to rally in earnest after turning for home, gained readily on the pacesetter during the run through the furlong grounds, struck the front in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole then dug in to stave off the fast-closing runner up. JOCKEY RIDGE reserved off the inside during the opening stages, was asked to pick up the pace nearing the five-sixteenths pole, swung sharply three wide into the stretch, displayed a good late kick to garner place honors. TUDOR KING quickly grabbed the lead, was well rated cutting the pace from the inside until the quarter pole, came out a bit in upper stretch, got nicely put on course soon afterwards, still held a clear advantage with a furlong remaining, yielded reluctantly at the sixteenth pole but continued on well to earn the show. FOLLIA three wide around the turn, swung into the lane one additional path wider, rallied mildly to secure the last major award. CONFLICTED raced along the outside, was asked for a response after entering the turn, but failed to gain ground appreciably. OVERLAP well placed along the inside, came up empty for the stretch run. CASH IS COHEN four wide around the turn, tired. QUIESCENT HIT was outprinted for the lead, despite being strongly encouraged leaving the starting gate, gave chase until the quarter pole and folded.
