Footnotes

STAY THIRSTY away in good order assumed a forward position soon after the start, had the lead between rivals upon entering the opening turn, was kept to a good hold and allowed to ease back a bit, conceding the front to SHACKLEFORD, nudged his way to be three wide once the aforementioned opponent tucked into the two path about midway down the backstretch, followed the leader closer and closer towards the inside, making it back into the two path by the half mile pole, ranged up to draw abreast of the pacesetter by midpoint on the far turn, edged away to a clear advantage, mildly hand urged to do so, led the field into the stretch and was set down, held safely throughout the stretch drive, kept busy to the end. RATTLESNAKE BRIDGE settled into midpack along the outside, sat reserved within range until the three-eighths pole, was asked for some run at that station, was maneuvered to be four wide a sixteenth later, got called upon and launched an earnest run at the leader, failed to dent the winner's margin during the ensuing furlong, forged on ahead, drifted outward gradually, in response to left handed stick work, had to settle for place honors. J W BLUE off a beat slowly, lagged towards the back of the pack for nearly three-quarters, began to pick up interest late on the far turn, came from the five path into the stretch, bumped lightly with MALIBU GLOW in upper stretch, getting briefly pushed a bit wider, altered course to the inside in the late stages to steer away from an errant RATTLESNAKE BRIDGE en route for the show. RULER ON ICE tucked along the rail a short distance from the starting gate, vied early, with two others perched directly to his outside, during the early stages, was content to allow SHACKLEFORD to show the way and rated kindly tracking that foe, was asked for some run leaving the three-eighths pole to keep pace, but flattened out. MALIBU GLOW was put to a snug hold while in a bit tight off heels early on the opening bend, sat reserved along the

outside between rivals for most of the run around the second turn, angled to be five wide in upper stretch, bumping lightly with J W BLUE to secure that position, lugged inward almost immediately and failed to make any significant headway on the front runners. MOONSHINE MULLIN strung out in the three path on the opening turn, pressed the issue from out there around the subsequent one, remained a prominent factor until the quarter pole before backing away. BOWMAN'S CAUSEWAY saved ground and was no factor. SHACKLEFORD made a three wide run to grab the lead, the outermost member of a threesome, cut the pace, well rated, was gradually guided over to the inside, making in over to the rail by the end of the backstretch, had the top one draw on even terms in the vicinity of three-eighths pole, offered briefly resistance before yielding, gave way after turning for home. RAISON D'ETAT three wide until midway on the far turn, came up empty after being asked for a response at the half mile pole. COIL three wide on the opening bend, remained well off the inside thereafter, and was never involved.
