CINCINNATI KID settled on the inside, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, shifted three wide outside the quarter-pole, closed well to make a bid in upper stretch, drew clear inside the furlong marker and held under strong urging. KNOCK QUIETLY settled on the inside, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole, moved out under left hand urging in upper stretch, switched to a right-handed whip near the sixteenth-pole and finished willingly for the place. POLARIS DREAM moved in before the first turn, was hard held while saving ground on that bend, came out early on the backstretch, stalked the leader on the outside, drew even with three furlongs to run, was asked at the top of the stretch, battled into the final furlong and weakened. WINDAFULL set the pace through solid fractions, was asked at the top of the stretch, vied into the final furlong and tired. FAST GRIEVANCE brushed with a rival after the start, went three wide on the first turn, settled well off the pace, was urged along while three wide on the far turn and failed to rally. GREELEY'S LAW bumped lightly with NYKID TIME TO JAZZ after the start, was reserved while off the inside, saved ground on the far turn, was asked near the five-sixteenths pole and also failed to rally. NYKID TIME TO JAZZ bumped lightly with GREELEY'S LAW after the start, lingered well back in the field, was roused while saving ground on

the far turn and failed to threaten. MAJESTY'S PILGRIM saved ground at the back on the first turn, lagged at the rear, went three then four wide on the far turn and was no factor. WHAT'S THE RECORD went two to three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, chased three then four wide on the far turn and came up empty. MIGHTYLOVER brushed with a rival after the start, went three wide on the first turn, settled towards the rear of the field and failed to respond. CARMEL BAY went four to five wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, came up empty on the far turn and faded. ZEN POWER went three to four wide on the first turn, moved in near the half-mile pole, came up empty on the far turn and stopped.
