FIRE ON ICE away in good order, was given a series of right handed choppy slaps from the whip in rapid succession leaving the starting gate, got put to a firm hold after achieving a forward position, vied for the lead, always placed at least slightly off the inside throughout the opening half, spurted away with a quick turn of speed approaching the head of the stretch, opening up a comfortable lead seemingly in the wink of an eye, was placed under a vigorous hand ride from the quarter pole to the sixteenth pole then geared down, occasionally flashed the whip from the right side before reaching the finish line. OUR ENTOURAGE was outhustled by a pair for early command, was urged along giving chase off the inside during the run around the bend, was left at a considerable distance behind the top one before reaching the top of the lane, unable to match that opponent's display of acceleration, held on well enough to secure second. PENN'S GRANT get off slowly, was given time to settle into stride, shadowed a rival outward soon after departing the backstretch, getting positioned nearly four wide in the vicinity of the seven-sixteenths pole, was taken hold and eased back slightly, ducked over to the two path once sufficiently clear of AWAITED, was already under encouragement swinging to be five wide at the top of the lane, came home with good energy, narrowly missing out on place honors. GOLD MEGILLAH was urged while taking the inside route on the turn, failed to gain any ground. CASUAL TRICK off alertly, pressed the issue from the outside for nearly a half, began to lose contact with the winner nearing the quarter pole and steadily tired thereafter. COVERT OPS raced along the outside, was asked for run early on the turn, failed to reach contention. AWAITED left the rail at the half mile pole, and was outrun. NEVER ON TIME broke awkwardly, pursued the front runners, three wide for most of the way on the turn, was through after completing a half.
