WILDCAT ALY chased the pace on the outside then four wide on the turn, gained the lead just inside the quarter-pole, drifted in while under a left-handed whip in upper stretch, switched to a right-handed whip near the furlong marker and edged clear under steady urging. MAGNIFICENT MIA broke out a bit at the start, chased the pace while leaning to the outside, lugged out while three wide on the turn, was only kept in that path because WILDCAT ALY was to her outside, dropped back after that rival passed her near the five-sixteenths pole, came under the whip in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick while able to get the place. HENNY'S HURRICANE bobbled at the start then brushed with a rival, settled at the rear while under some urging, went two then three wide on the turn, swung four wide into the stretch, came under a left-handed whip and got up for the show at the wire. VICTORIA LYNN came away in good order, raced just off the pace while under some urging, drafted behind the pacesetter while in hand and off the rail early on the turn, dropped to the inside in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, was asked shortly thereafter, cut the corner into the stretch, chased the winner under a right-handed whip and weakened in the final furlong then was caught for the show. PERFECT EMBRACE was hustled to the lead, set the pace through sensible fractions, vied off the rail on the turn, lost the advantage at the top of the stretch, was put to a drive, dropped back nearing the furlong marker and gave way. SANTORINI MOON bobbled at the start, settled off the pace, was urged while inside on the turn and failed to respond.
