SEE ME PROUD moved in at the back of the field, saved ground on the first turn, settled nicely at the rear of the field, was asked outside the seven-sixteenths pole, raced off the hedge while advancing early on the far turn, angled five wide passing the five-sixteenths pole, circled rivals while remaining five wide into the stretch, dropped in some while closing strongly on the outside under right hand urging, grabbed the lead just inside the sixteenth-pole and prevailed under continued right hand encouragement. MYHORSEOFCOURSE was grabbed with the left-rein just after the start, settled on the inside, was asked outside the seven-sixteenths pole, raced inside early on the far turn, came off the rail briefly near the five-sixteenths pole, opted to stay inside and dropped back to the hedge, cut the corner into the stretch, moved out under a drive near the three-sixteenths pole, was put to a right-handed whip, chased determinedly into the final furlong, was switched to a left-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole and finished strongly but missed. PARACHUTE CONEY moved up between rivals passing the wire the first time, went two then three wide on the first turn, prompted the pacesetter on the outside, moved to the lead outside the half-mile pole, vied inside on the far turn, was challenged by IMPERIAL ROBYN outside the quarter-pole, cut the corner into the stretch while the aforementioned rival drifted wide, was challenged again quickly while under a right-handed whip, battled determinedly into the final furlong, was switched to a left-handed whip shortly thereafter, fought gamely into the final sixteenth but was outfinished while able to get the show. IMPERIAL ROBYN came out at the start but quickly showed in front, held a clear lead in the early stages then was taken under a light hold, was joined on the outside by two opponents passing the wire the first time, lugged out a bit while negotiating the midway point on the first turn, set the pace towards the inside, lost the lead outside the half-mile pole then dropped back, chased inside early on the far turn, came off the inside and bumped lightly with SLINGER near the five-sixteenths pole, made a bid shortly thereafter, drifted four wide into the stretch, dropped back in while battling with PARACHUTE CONEY under the whip, fought with that rival into the final sixteenth and was also outfinished then missed the show. ENGLISH MAJOR raced a bit off the hedge on the initial turn, settled in the middle of the field, was put to a drive when SLINGER made an early move outside the half-mile pole, continued under a drive in an attempt to advance between rivals, failed to gather the needed momentum, went three wide to four wide on the far turn, bumped with GIANT INDIAN near the five-sixteenths pole, altered course to the inside at the top of the stretch and failed to respond. SLINGER was placed under a short hold soon after the start, went three then two wide on the first turn, made a strong middle move when removed from cover, moved up near the lead approaching the half-mile pole, went two to three wide on the far turn, bumped lightly with IMPERIAL ROBYN near the five-sixteenths pole, dropped back into the stretch and

had nothing left. GIANT INDIAN hit the outside of the gate soundly at the start, moved up on the outside of two rivals passing the wire the first time, went three wide on the first bend, was forwardly placed on the outside, chased four to five wide on the far turn, bumped with ENGLISH MAJOR near the five-sixteenths pole and dropped out then was not urged late.
