Footnotes

LEAP was ridden along on the outside, went three wide on the turn, came under a right-handed whip in upper stretch, was well behind COMADANTE into the final furlong, switched to a left-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole, gained ground on the tired leader late and got up at the wire in a prolonged drive. COMADANTE came away in good order, showed good speed, set the pace, controlled the action while near the inside on the turn, responded well when given one crack of a right-handed whip near the three-sixteenths pole, was quickly switched to a left-handed whip, extended the advantage into the final furlong, remained well clear into the final sixteenth but shortened stride and was caught. WESTERN GRIT was urged along while just off the pace, raced off the rail while a bit green on the turn, was put to the whip in upper stretch, came between rivals outside the sixteenth-pole and finished willingly to secure the show. CAN'T CATCH ME NOW stumbled at the start but recovered quickly, moved up to race just off the pace, was coaxed along behind the pacesetter while inside on the turn, came under the whip in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick. SHOT ROCK chased the pace, raced off the rail on the turn, came under a stronger rider near the five-sixteenths pole, pursued the solo leader while under the whip in upper stretch and also lacked the needed kick. JAMES JINGLE broke out at the start then was quickly corrected, was ridden along towards the rear, raced inside on the turn, came off the rail outside the quarter-pole, shifted three wide into the stretch and failed to respond. SATURDAY APPEAL was ridden along towards the back, dropped further behind while two to three wide on the turn and failed to threaten. ALCOLITE broke a bit slow then was grabbed with the left-rein, dropped well behind, raced inside early on the turn then came off the rail, shifted three wide outside the five-sixteenths pole, came four wide into the stretch and was no factor.
