TOMISUE'S DELIGHT, unhurried along the inside early, advanced on the rail on the backstretch but was shuffled back nearing the final turn then came again on the rail, altered course for running room in upper stretch and was along in the late stages. TUZIA came away awkwardly but raced in close attendance to the pace early, advanced inside on the second turn, dug in gamely while between rivals in the stretch and stayed gamely to earn the place. ONE RICH LADY showed good speed from the outside while in hand, rallied three wide on the second turn and battled gamely on down to the wire. DEWARS ROCKS off awkwardly and outrun early, advanced inside on the final turn, swung wide for the drive and finished well from the far outside. AMARILLO, rated along early, put in a good run along the inside nearing the stretch but had nothing left for the drive. ESCENA quickly showed in front, set the pace while in hand, stayed well along the rail into midstretch but gave way in the final furlong. TUXEDO JUNCTION was hard-ridden but offered no response. ALDIZA chased the pace from the outside and tired badly through the stretch.
