Footnotes

COMIC STRIP, rated along early, advanced three wide on the second turn, dug in determinedly when roused for the drive and drew clear. DIVIDE AND CONQUER, rated along inside, advanced inside on the second turn, came wide for the drive and finished gamely from the outside. BOMFIM set the pace along the inside while in hand and stayed on gamely to the finish. JOE WHO (BRZ), four wide on the first turn and inside on the second turn, altered course to the outside in upper stretch and finished gamely. MIDDLESEX DRIVE, rated along between rivals, put in a four wide run approaching the stretch but could not sustain that bid. CRYPTIC RASCAL, close up inside while in hand, saved ground into the stretch but was blocked along the inside in the drive. STAR CONNECTION contested the pace from the outside and tired in the final furlong. DR FONG raced close up while in hand, came three wide for the drive but came up empty when called on. STAY SOUND, outrun early, raced four wide on the second turn and had no response when roused. MUSICAL GHOST raced three wide on both turns and tired. GOLDEN DICE, rated outside, came wide into the stretch but had no rally.
