Footnotes

SOARING AWAY trailed for five furlongs after being pinched back at the start, circled five wide while launching his bid on the turn then closed strongly in the middle of the track to get up in the final seventy yards. CARTAGE AGENT settled just off the early pace, took up chase after the leader on the turn, surged to the front in midstretch but couldn't withstand the winner's late charge. SEE LATHAM was shuffled back entering the backstretch, steadied along the inside on the far turn, saved ground to the top of the stretch, altered course to the outside in upper stretch then rallied belatedly in the middle of the track. POTOMAC CHASE raced just off the pace for a half, rallied three wide to threaten at the top of the stretch but couldn't sustain his rally. GRAVE DIGGER strung out four wide on the first turn, rushed up to take the lead along the backstretch, set the pace into midstretch then weakened under pressure in the final eighth. TEN MITCHELL was unhurried along the backstretch, rallied four wide to reach contention on the turn and flattened out. WOODNOTE dueled along the rail for a half, dropped back while saving ground on the turn then lacked a strong closing bid. SIR FOREST was outrun for six furlongs, rallied between horses on the turn, altered course to the inside in upper stretch and finished evenly. BLUESMAN raced in the middle of the pack to the turn, steadied behind horses at the top of the stretch then raced in traffic through the lane. STEALTH FLIER bumped at the start, failed to mount a serious rally while racing wide.
