SILVER TRAIN rushed up between horses, dueled three wide to the turn, shook loose in upper stretch and drew away while being kept to the task. COMMANDER PAT settled just behind the leaders while saving ground, launched a rally along the inside leaving the turn and finished willingly to gain a share. MALHEUR bumped at the start, moved up from outside, pressed the pace outside the winner leaving the turn then weakened slightly in the final eighth. SUN KING broke awkwardly, raced far back while trailing to the turn then raced erratically while rallying belatedly through the stretch. SURVIVALIST raced in the middle of the pack from outside along the backstretch, circled five wide on the turn then failed to threaten while improving his position. SCOTT'S CAT raced far back while saving ground to the turn, steadied along the rail in upper stretch and failed to threaten thereafter. TANI MARU raced in the middle of the pack along the backstretch, steadied along the inside on the far turn, swung five wide entering the stretch then flattened out. DYNWHITE was reserved early, made a run four wide to threaten on the turn then flattened out. INTERPATATION was never a factor. TUCAN bumped at the start, dueled along the rail to the far turn and steadily tired thereafter. QUIET RETALIATION bumped at the start, steadied in traffic on the far turn and was never close thereafter. STUDENT COUNCIL bumped at the start, raced five wide throughout.
