

Footnotes

SMOKEY GLACKEN moved up quickly to gain the early advantage, drifted out along the backstretch, set a rapid pace to the turn, dug in when threatened in upper stretch, extended her lead in midstretch then edged away under steady right hand encouragement. GRAND PRAYER was outrun along the backstretch, saved ground while gaining on the turn, angled four wide while splitting horses to get clear in upper stretch then finished strongly from outside to edge FELINE STORY for the place. FELINE STORY settled just off the early pace after breaking slowly, rallied along the rail on the turn, lodged a mild bid along the rail in upper stretch and weakened in the final eighth. HERMIONE'S MAGIC altered course inside the winner along the backstretch, raced up close to the turn, lodged a mild rally between horses at the top of the stretch but couldn't sustain her bid. IRISH MELODY raced far back to the turn then failed to threaten while improving her position. PROSPECTIVE SAINT chased the leaders while four wide to the top of the stretch and steadily tired thereafter. WILDCARD CAT raced within striking distance while five wide to the turn and lacked a further response.
