Footnotes

DISCREETLY MINE broke running to take charge early, was rated on the lead from the two path until the quarter pole, responded well when put to encouragement, began to shorten stride a bit nearing the sixteenth pole, but held sway while drifting outward a couple of paths late from the strong left handed pressure being applied by the rider. BANK MERGER reserved four wide, was roused coming to the three-eighths pole, got the best of D'FUNNYBONE after bumping with that rival in the race for the four path spinning into the lane, finished willingly during the stretch drive to earn the place. LATIGO SHORE off a beat slowly, appeared sluggish during the opening stages, rode the rail until the five-sixteenths pole, proceeded to angle five wide into the stretch, lacked the necessary kick to reel in the top one. HURRICANE IKE bumped lightly with D'FUNNYBONE at the break, went on to take the inside route, rallied into contention to loom a serious threat with an eighth to go, but could not sustain the bid. IN JACK'S MEMORY stumbled at the start, was taken to the rail at the half mile pole, took the inside route around the turn, came up empty when called upon for the stretch drive. BULLDOGGER urged to a forward position, took up chase from the three path, was put to a prolonged drive on the turn, before backing off. D' FUNNYBONE bumped lightly with HURRICANE IKE at the start, raced along the outside within range, bumped with BANK MERGER attempting to swing four wide into the stretch, then steadied shortly thereafter in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole while tiring.
