Footnotes

WAR HOOT away well from the gate, was aggressively taken back during the straightaway approach leading to the opening bend, while being guided over to the hedge, proceeded to take the inside route, unhurried and under a good hold, crept up nearing the quarter pole, was forced to remain on hold as the field turned for home, gained clearance when STAYING ON angled outward, cut the corner, scampering by those rivals who had chosen a much wider route into the lane, rapidly closed in on the front runners, grabbed the lead just past the eighth pole, was nearly clear when he came out, stubbornly resisting the strong right handed pressure being applied by the rider, and slightly impeding KARAKORUM LEGEND, got put back on a truer course soon afterwards and edged clear. MIDNIGHT MISCHIEF accompanied the pacesetter from the outside, being rated all the while, moved up with some encouragement to issue a challenge for the lead nearing the head of the stretch, battled gamely throughout the stretch run, but had to settle for place honors. INSIDER TIP patiently saved ground during the initial stages, availed of the opportunity to slip outward near the midway point on the second turn, came home with good energy under steady encouragement down the center of the course en route for the show. KARAKORUM LEGEND made the lead in short order under his own power, set the pace towards the inside while continuing along not being urged until the quarter pole, was let out a notch in anticipation of several rivals making their move heading into the stretch, dug in stubbornly during the run through the furlong grounds, yielded reluctantly soon afterwards, then was

steadied ever so slightly when the top one drifted out several paths in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole. AIKENITE strung out four wide entering the first turn, settled into the three path after circling by RESCUE SQUAD, stalked the leader from there, was urged along to make a bid approaching the quarter pole, but failed to sustain the move. RESCUE SQUAD underwent a wide journey and had no serious stretch offering. STAYING ON (IRE) rank being rated leaving the starting gate, acted more kindly after reaching the opening bend, saved ground, within good striking position, angled out nearing the quarter pole, gearing up for the stretch drive, but failed to fire once called upon. EN FUEGO strung out three wide around both turns, fanned five wide into the lane but was outkicked. THABAZIMBI raced along the outside and was through after going six furlongs. MORE THAN WILLING tired steadily after completing three-quarters and was subsequently vanned off after the finish.
