WILD EVENT, close up inside while in hand, saved ground into the stretch, angled out for running room in upper stretch, dug in resolutely from the outside and caught pacesetter BOMFIM in the final strides. BOMFIM flashed good speed, set the pace while in hand, drew clear in upper stretch then dug in determinedly but could not hold off the winner. ROB 'N GIN, with the pace from the outside under wraps, put in a wide run on the second turn but faded in the stretch. BOYCE, rated outside, raced wide and had no solid closing kick. GARBU chased the pace for three quarters and tired in the stretch. HONOR GLIDE, outrun early, came wide for the drive but had little to offer when roused. LONG WAR had no response after a wide trip. THESAURUS raced inside and had no response when roused. TAHMID, taken back in the early going, raced wide on the second turn and had no response. JAMBALAYA JAZZ tired badly. SOVIET LINE was steadied on the first turn and outrun thereafter.
