CORONADO'S QUEST, away in good order and with the pace while three wide into the first turn, attended the pace from the outside, moved three wide to take control leaving the backstretch, settled into the stretch with a clear lead, dug in gamely when put to the test in deep stretch and held on in a rousing finish. VICTORY GALLOP broke to the inside, bumping RAFFIE'S MAJESTY then settled into stride in close attendance from the outside, advanced outside on the second turn and finished fast, just missing. RAFFIE'S MAJESTY, bumped at the start and unhurried while outrun early, rallied four wide on the second turn and finished with a rush from the far outside. ARCHERS BAY, bumped after the start and rated along inside, saved ground into the stretch and finished with good interest, GRAND SLAM prompted the pace from between rivals and tired in the stretch. DEPUTY DIAMOND, bumped and pinched back at the start, raced along the inside just behind the leaders, was steadied slightly on the second turn and lacked a solid closing kick. DICE DANCER showed in front after the start, made the pace for three quarters then tired badly in the stretch run.
