LUCKY LIVI, bumped at the start and hustled up inside to get the lead, set the pace, drew clear when roused then dug in and held off MIKE'S WAY under a steady drive. MIKE'S WAY, bumped at the start and hustled outside, chased the pace and finished gamely. ALL SPADES raced three wide on the turn and finished with good courage. DEVIL'S FIDDLER came wide for the drive and finished gamely outside. SARAH'S WORLD bobbled at the start, bumped with MIKE'S WAY, contested the pace into the stretch and tired in the final furlong. PINE FOREST, bumped at the start and outrun inside early on, altered course in the stretch but lacked a rally. PEARLS OF GLORY chased the pace along the rail and tired in the stretch. HERA was taken up along the inside at the half mile pole, dropped back, came wide for the drive but lacked a rally. BONE OF CONTENTION raced greenly and tired.
