RUNNING STAG pulled himself into a striking position while three wide, stalked the pace from the outside, drew clear when set down turning for home and prevailed under a drive. CATIENUS, rated along early, advanced outside on the second turn, came wide into the stretch, responded when roused and finished gamely from the outside. GOLDEN MISSILE stumbled at the start, was rank while under wraps between rivals early on, rallied outside approaching the stretch and stayed on gamely to the finish. EARLY WARNING quickly showed in front, set the pace along the inside, could not stay with the winner in upper stretch and tired in the final furlong. NITE DREAMER raced with the pace while between rivals and came up empty when roused on the second turn. TEJANO COUTURE raced close up inside while in hand, saved ground and tired. MT. SASSAFRAS chased the pace while three wide and tired. FIRE AND RAIN had no response when roused.
