ERMELINDA was outrun early, rallied four wide on the second turn and finished gamely outside. QUEENOFEVERYTHING chased the pace and stayed on gamely through the stretch. VESPERS raced close up early and stayed on gamely to the finish. SKATESHEBA (FR) was rated along early, raced inside and encountered traffic along the inside in the stretch. PHILANTHA was rated along early, came wide for the drive and had no rally. HOLY TREASURE had no rally. SARATOGAN raced wide and tired in the stretch. IMPEACHABLE AFFAIR was outrun. REMEDIATE raced wide on the first turn and tired. PATINHAM (IRE) chased three wide, tired and was vanned off after the finish. JEWEL OF THE NORTH tired.
