J BE K took the lead and angled in along the backstretch, opened a clear advantage on the turn then drew off under a vigorous hand ride setting a track record in the process. MR. SHORTCAKE settled just off the pace while three wide to the top of the stretch and finished willingly for the place while no match for the winner. SARATOGA SEVEN pressed the pace outside the winner into upper stretch and weakened from his early efforts. FIERCE WIND checked after breaking inward and bumping with I'M SO LUCKY at the start, was outrun to the turn, angled five wide at the quarter pole and failed to threaten while improving his position. I'M SO LUCKY checked and was pinched back at the start, exchanged bumps with ARTYTHEONEMANPARTY along the backstretch, raced greenly between horses on the turn and lacked a rally. TOOLS FOR THE JOB stumbled after the start and was bumped, checked in tight along the rail at the half mile pole then angled out, raced between horses to the turn and steadily tired thereafter. EXOTIC STORY was outrun early after breaking slowly, made a five wide move on the turn and flattened out. TEN BAGGER ,bumped at the start, saved ground and tired. ARTYTHEONEMANPARTY was bumped along the backstretch and was never close thereafter.
