Footnotes

SEPARATIST settled in good position, steadied along the rail et the three-eighths pole, split horses on the turn, took charge in midstretch and drew away under right hand urging. INHERIT THE GOLD stalked the pace from outside, lodged a bid midway on the turn, but was no match for the winner while clearly second best. COPS FEVER saved ground, swung four wide on the turn and rallied mildly. CARRY THE DAY was outrun to the turn and passed only tiring horses. PEGASUS TOMMY D. was under a firm hold while racing wide and lacked the needed response when called upon. HER LATEST FLAME pressed the pace from outside, gained the lead on the turn then gave way in upper stretch. KNIFE AND FORK was never a factor. HEAVENLY BLAZE was pinched at the start and failed to threaten while four wide. THE PLOT THICKENS set the pace on the rail and gave way on the far turn.
