MUSIC NOTE settled just off the early pace, moved through a narrow opening along the rail to gain a slim lead nearing the far turn, battled heads apart outside INDIAN BLESSING leaving the quarter pole, shook off that one to gain a clear advantage in midstretch then drew away under a vigorous hand ride. INDIAN BLESSING was bumped a bit at the start, rushed up from outside to contest the early pace, relinquished the lead to the winner on the far turn, pressed the issue outside that one to the top of the stretch, couldn't stay with the winner in midstretch but continued on gamely to hold well for the place. INFORMED DECISION checked slightly and moved out on the backstretch, circled four wide leaving the turn and rallied mildly to gain a share. P. S. U. GRAD broke inward bumping with INDIAN BLESSING at the start, angled in, raced well back while saving ground on the turn and lacked a strong closing response. TAR HEEL MOM raced in tight between horses at the half mile pole, dropped back on the turn, angled out in upper stretch and tired badly.
