Footnotes

GET STORMY sprinted clear on the rail, raced uncontested on the front into the stretch, extended his advantage in midstretch and held off the runner-up under right hand urging. MIKOSHI was well placed along the rail for five furlongs, saved ground leaving the turn, angled out in upper stretch and steadily gained on the winner at the finish. GOLDEN MEXICO (IRE) checked in traffic on the first turn, raced just off the pace for a half, steadied in traffic on the far turn, waited on the turn, angled three wide entering the stretch and lacked a late response. JACK SPRATT was outrun to the turn and closed mildly along the inside. STRIKE AGAIN pressed the winner from outside to the top of the stretch and steadily tired thereafter. BROTHER KEITH steadied in traffic on the first turn, raced in midpack while four wide for six furlongs and lacked a late response. FLORENTINO (JPN) checked early between horses, raced within striking distance three wide to the turn and lacked a further response. SMARTEN DESTINY never reached contention while wide throughout. WICKED RICH was never a serious threat.
