PERSISTENTLY sat reserved off the early pace activity three wide, continued to bide her time during the run down the backstretch, began to close in approaching the far turn, gained more significantly after being roused coming to the three-eighths pole, swung four wide into the lane, losing a bit of momentum as a result, continued the chase through the furlong grounds, narrowed in on the weakening leader with about a sixteenth to go, then successfully wore down that rival a couple of strides prior to the end. RACHEL ALEXANDRA away in good order, stubbornly held her ground from the three path during the straightaway approach leading to the opening bend, cut the fractions, well rated and well off the inside, under the watchful eye of LIFE AT TEN, inched closer to the two path departing the backstretch, sat chilly, fending off the abbreviated bid of the aforementioned rival as that duo approached the quarter pole, spurted away after having been asked for run herself, emerged from the furlong grounds with a sizeable advantage, began to shorten stride with less than a sixteenth to go, finally relinquishing the lead a couple of jumps before the finish line. LIFE AT TEN strung out four wide by RACHEL ALEXANDRA nearing the first turn, continued the pursuit from out there, with the rider attempting to keep something in reserve, unleashed her challenge for the lead coming to the five-sixteenths pole, was rebuffed by the head of the stretch and steadily tired thereafter. MISS SINGHSIX (IRE) raced along the outside, closed a bit of the lengthy gap with a half mile remaining, drifted out in upper stretch from strong left handed encouragement. CLASSOFSIXTYTHREE the last to pop of the starting gate, was guided over to the rail soon after the start, took the inside route thereafter and failed to reach a contending position.
