BLUSHING DIXIE away in good order, assumed a good position during the straightaway approach leading up to the opening bend, tracked the front runner from the rail, under a firm hold, was forced to be kept on hold nearing the quarter pole, spied the necessary clearance a couple of strides into the stretch run, was forced to squeeze by along the left side of MISS TEQUILA after that foe came in a bit, doing her best to protect the lead, then dug in with good determination to stave off the fast-closing runner up. APHRODITE'S TEARS devoid of early speed, dropped to the back of the pack soon after the start, lagged behind, unhurried for nearly six furlongs, was asked to pick up the pace in preparation for the stretch drive, fanned five wide turning for home, took off in earnest after being straightened away, charged down the outside of the course with a strong kick to garner place honors. DEPUTY'S CITIZEN attended the pace from the outside, being rated all the while, moved when ready coming to the quarter pole, remained a prominent factor during the ensuing furlong before being outfinished in the late stages. MUCH FANFARE saved ground and lacked the needed response. JAZZY MOVES was taken out to the three path departing the backstretch, rallied mildly to improve position. SIMPLE WESTERN took the inside route under a firm hold, bided her time during the run around the second bend, angled outward into the two path turning for home, got caught in traffic approaching the eighth pole, was clear a sixteenth later, but failed to muster up a solid closing response. PROVEN RIGHT within range three wide on the far turn, tired. BACK IN FASHION three wide around the far turn, had no rally. MISS TEQUILA eager for the lead, was lightly throttled down by the rider in attempt to conserve some energy, after reaching the backstretch, continued showing the way towards the inside, unchallenged until nearing the quarter pole, came in a bit in upper stretch as the top one approached to her left side, gave way after leaving the furlong grounds.
