WOW WOW WOV cleared the field under his own power to assume command, sped off to an open lead during the run around the opening bend, continued along, well rated in the two path, and unchallenged, worked his way over to the rail by midway on the far turn, increased the advantage after being put to encouragement in upper stretch, then held safely, being kept busy. ZAPSTER sat reserved along the inside during the initial stages, was guided out to the two path midway down the backstretch, remained within striking position and still on hold until nearing the quarter pole, was called upon after entering the stretch, raced between rivals from the three-sixteenths pole until the eighth pole, continued after the winner after successfully splitting that pair, but proved no match, en route for second. KING ROCK off alertly, was taken hold of as the top one went zooming by for the front, loosely tracked that rival from the hedge, under a firm hold, took off in earnest swinging into the lane, but was outkicked by the top duo during the last eighth. TRIPPO reserved along the outside, swung from the two path into the stretch, remained on hold, awaiting options, while lacking optimal racing clearance, altered course outward in the vicinity of the three-sixteenths pole after surveying a clear pathway to the finish line and came home with good late foot.. MIDNIGHT MASS saved ground and lacked a solid stretch response. TICONDERO raced along the outside and failed to display the needed kick. DEVONSHIRE bumped at the break, jostled with QUIET ALL AMERICAN for position soon after leaving the starting gate, got the best of that rival, settled along the outside, weakly pursued the pacesetter from the three path, was taken one path closer to the inside, loosely drafted behind the leader for a couple of strides, had nothing left to offer after turning for home. QUIET ALL AMERICAN bumped with DEVONSHIRE at the start, jostled with the same opponent, fighting for position in the early

stages, backed off and tucked to the inside just before reaching the first turn, remained a forward factor for three-quarters and tired. QUAY LIME GUY three wide around both turns, lugged in while tiring at the three-sixteenths pole. WILDLEE SPECIAL off to an awkward beginning, trailed throughout.
