NEED AN ANGEL pressed the pace on the inside, chased while saving ground on the turn, made a rail bid outside the quarter-pole, came under right hand urging in upper stretch, drifted out a bit nearing the sixteenth-pole and proved best under continued right hand urging. CELEBRITY SIGHTING prompted the pace on the outside, drew even while three wide on the turn, was asked while in front near the five-sixteenths pole, dropped to one off the rail entering the stretch, battled on the outside with NEED AN ANGEL and was outfinished while able to hold the place. ROYAL LAHAINA was urged along while off the pace, went two to three wide on the turn, came under a drive in upper stretch, moved in during the final furlong and finished with good energy but reached her best stride too late while up for the show. FLYING TRAIN was bumped soundly at the start and bounced around between rivals, moved up while eager then was taken in hand off heels, chased two then three wide on the turn, moved to four wide near the five-sixteenths pole, dropped to three wide into the stretch, came under the whip and lacked the needed response. CAUTIONARY TALE broke out and bumped hard with FLYING TRAIN then was taken up, raced well back in the field while under some urging, went three then four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and rallied belatedly. SOUNDWAVE was urged along while off the pace, saved ground on the turn, came under the whip near the five-sixteenths pole, moved off the rail at the top of the stretch and failed to rally. ISLAND BOUND was urged along on the inside, saved ground on the turn and failed to threaten. BEAUTIFULNIGHTMARE bumped with FLYING TRAIN at the start, moved to the lead, set the pace while under some restraint, vied off the rail on the turn, lost the lead outside the five-sixteenths pole and faded.
