MINERALOGIST tucked over to the rail soon after the start, rated kindly, unhurried until reaching the far turn, was let out a notch midpoint, still a bit more a sixteenth down the road, until fully roused turning for home, all the while having a secured a good striking position, was moving willingly and attempting to slip through a narrow opening to the inside of SPA CITY PRINCESS, when the aforementioned rival drifted inward slightly, but apparently enough to shut down that passageway, steadied and expertly altered course outward, losing only the barest of her momentum, got going again and came home with a flourish to prove best in a four way blanket finish. BANKER'S BUY assumed a forward position leaving the starting gate, stalked the pacesetter from the outside, lightly coaxed along to maintain interest, gradually ranged up to the pacesetter upon reaching the far turn, was abreast of the leader as the pair headed for the top of the stretch, got set down as a hard fought stretch battle commenced, fought her way to a very slim advantage with about seventy yards to go, dug in stubbornly but got nailed right at the wire. GO UNBRIDLED broke inward a step or two, was content to lag at the rear of the pack along the outside, was asked for some run and began to pick up the pace midway on the far turn, finished with good late energy, but had to settle for show honors. SPA CITY PRINCESS quickly established control, showed the way from the inside, rated on a loosely-contested lead, felt some pressure for the initial time near the three-eighths pole, had the rider ask for a response about a sixteenth later, came under intense pressure from both sides during the run through the furlong grounds, reluctantly yielded leaving the sixteenth pole. D' ORATORY placed in the three path at the seven-sixteenths pole, weakened. BEAUTIFUL RISK strung out four wide on the far turn, folded.
