WEEKEND HIDEAWAY broke fast from the outside post, was taken in hand and allowed CAY TO POMEROY to set the pace, stalked that opponent while under a snug hold on the outside, turned up the pressure while three wide on the turn, dropped to one off the while nearing the quarter-pole, gained the lead when set down after straightening for the drive, kicked clear in upper stretch, was put to a right-handed whip near the furlong marker and drew away under a strong drive. SLOT PLAY was bumped at the start then carried in, raced at the rear while ridden along, saved ground on the turn, angled out in upper stretch and got up for the place. MR RODRIGUEZ lost his footing at the start but broke with the field, was urged along while on the outside, chased four wide on the turn, dropped to three wide nearing the quarter-pole, came under the whip and tired then missed the place. CAY TO POMEROY bumped with SLOT PLAY at the start then came in, moved to the lead, set the pace through solid fractions while off the rail, came under pressure on the turn, dropped to the inside approaching the quarter-pole, lost the lead to the winner after straightening for the drive and weakened. AWESOME WEEKEND was well placed just off the pace, raced near the inside while under urging on the turn, was put to a stronger ride outside the quarter-pole and came up empty.
