Footnotes

LITTLE ROCKET moved up after the start, took the lead with five furlongs to run while inside of a rival, inched clear near the seven-sixteenths pole, controlled the action while near the rail through the turn, responded well when set down just after turning into the stretch, extended the advantage while being tapped with a down-turned whip into the final furlong and held well. KEEP BUSTIN moved up after the start, was outprinted to the lead, chased the pace near the inside, was ridden along while off the inside on the turn, came under a right-handed whip coming to the quarter-pole, pursued the leader into the final furlong, switched to a left-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole and finished with good courage but failed to reach the winner. HOT SPLASH settled at the rear of the field, went three then two wide early on the turn, bided his time at the back, dropped to the inside at the quarter-pole, was asked while cutting the corner into the stretch and lacked the needed response while just able to get the show. FIFTYFOUR FOREVER showed early speed, relinquished the lead with five furlongs to run, pressed the pace on the outside from that point, chased three wide on the turn, pursued the winner under the whip in upper stretch and tired. PRINCESS MARA was hustled from the start, raced just off the pace on the outside, chased four wide on the turn and weakened. LENDERS WAY was coaxed along on the inside of a rival, brushed with HALDANE outside the half-mile pole, raced inside on the turn, was asked at the five-sixteenths, came off the rail at the top of the stretch and failed to threaten. HALDANE settled on the outside of her entymate, brushed with that rival outside the half-mile pole, was roused while three wide on the turn and failed to respond. HUNDRED ACRE WOOD was urged along on the outside, went four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and was no factor.
