Footnotes

NUFFSAID NUFFSAID broke inward, went on to secure a forward position, pressed the issue from the two path, overhauled MARGARET LILIAN about halfway around the turn and was sent over to the rail, edged away to a comfortable advantage, entered the stretch and got put to a drive, remained well in the clear, with none behind posing as a threat. VICTORY ISLAND out a couple of steps at the start, was pulled away from the closest opponent in time to prevent any significant contact, gave chase from the two path, attempted to challenge spinning into the stretch, wasn't up to the task at hand, had little difficulty holding on to the place award. GO OLIVIA GO tracked the front runners while taking the inside route, held the show. WORLD PREMIER gently

pinched, after getting brushed from both sides at the start, gave chase from the two path, had no late response. QUEEN NINE steadied after getting bumped soundly at the break, raced mostly two wide on the turn, had no solid closing punch. QUIET SUNSHINE towards the inside, made no serious moves. JOLIENNE loosely pocketed for a half, tired. PRIVATE COUNCEL saved ground to no avail. FLASHY IN PINK made solid contact with QUEEN NINE very shortly after brushing with WARRIOR MARIE, was four wide entering the turn, and six wide exiting it, lacked the necessary stretch response. WARRIOR MARIE lightly bumped at the start, departed the backstretch three wide, failed to reach a contending position. MARGARET LILIAN was pulling on the bit getting placed along the rail early down the backstretch, offered little resistance getting replaced by the top one, faded in the lane. FULL OF INTENT bumped soundly at the start, commenced the run around the bend from the three path, was done after completing a half.
