CONFESSIONAL showed good speed from the outside, raced with the pace while in hand, advanced four wide on the turn, drew clear leaving the eighth pole and was kept to a drive to the wire. ITSY BITSY BETSY contested the pace while between rivals and dug in gamely along the rail through the stretch. LA VILLE ROUGE, close up outside, came wide for the drive and offered a mild rally in the middle of the track. BLISSFUL came away awkwardly and was put to heavy pressure soon after the start then lugged in in upper stretch. BASEDONPRINCIPLE showed good speed while three wide and tired in the stretch. SEDUCER showed brief speed on the rail and stopped. KITRIDGE BAY raced on the rail and tired. CIVILYNN tired badly and was being eased in the late stages.
