Footnotes

SERENDIPITOUS was unhurried for five furlongs, raced in traffic along the inside on the far turn, angled out while gaining on the turn, split horses while five wide entering the stretch then closed steadily to get up in the final seventy yards. SHADOW PLAY sprinted clear in the early stages, set the pace along the inside for seven furlongs, extended her advantage in midstretch, led into deep stretch but couldn't hold the winner safe. COZY CAY checked along the inside on the first turn, raced just off the pace along the rail to the turn, angled out in midstretch then finished well to gain a share. TOTALLY COSMIC chased the pacesetter while in hand to the turn then lacked the needed response when called upon. PARADING TOMISUE trailed to the far turn, circled wide into the stretch then rallied mildly from outside. JOYFUL CHAOS raced well back along the inside to the turn, angled out in upper stretch and failed to threaten while improving her position. ELLIEONTHEMARCH raced in close contention from outside for seven furlongs and steadily tired thereafter. SILVER CLIPPER raced in the middle of the pack for a half, dropped back on the far turn, circled six wide into the stretch and lacked a strong closing bid. DEFLATION checked slightly on the first turn, raced within striking distance to the turn and faded in the stretch. RIGHT OUT RO was never a factor while four wide. VICEREINE (GB) saved ground to no avail. OHBEEGEEWHYEN raced between horses to the far turn and faded.
