### Footnotes

SUCCESSFUL WAYS sprinted clear in the early stages, raced uncontested on the lead into upper stretch, dug in when challenged a sixteenth out and fought back along the rail to prevail in the closing strides. HOMETOWN BOY was outrun early after breaking poorly, moved up along the backstretch, checked while racing greenly behind horses on the far turn, swung five wide at the quarter pole, made a strong run to challenge in deep stretch and lost the bob. REAFFIRM raced just off the pace to the turn, rallied four wide to threaten in upper stretch and finished willingly to gain a share. MEDIA CITY stalked three wide to the turn, lodged a mild bid in upper stretch and flattened out. RED GREELEY devoid of early speed, raced far back along the rail for a half, came out in upper stretch and closed some ground late. MAVEN angled in early, raced well back while saving ground the entire way and lacked the needed response when called upon. STRAIGHT ROMANCE chased along the rail into upper stretch and gave way. A P SPEEDWAY never reached contention.
