HASTEN TO BE KING bumped with rivals on both sides at the start then steadied, raced at the rear of the field while on the outside, was urged some while mostly three wide on the turn, came under strong urging approaching the quarter-pole, was put to a right-handed whip while five wide into the stretch, commenced a rally with the rider throwing several hard crosses near the three-sixteenths pole, was switched to a left-handed whip just inside the furlong marker, closed with a rush while under repeated and vigorous left hand urging late and got up in the final strides. GRAND TERROR bumped with the winner just after the start, showed good speed, eased back behind the heavily asked DADE CITY near the five-eighths pole to avoid an inside duel, moved to the outside of that rival with a half-mile to run, advanced to make a bid in the vicinity of the three-eighths pole, inched clear coming to the quarter-pole, responded fairly well when put to a drive in upper stretch, drifted in while clear near the sixteenth-pole then was caught in the shadow of the wire. SCOTCHIRISH was bumped on both sides at the start and taken up slightly, showed early speed then was asked to settle, was well placed while off the rail on the turn, came under urging nearing the quarter-pole, rallied inside of GRAND TERROR in upper stretch, loomed a threat while inside entering the final furlong, altered course to the outside when GRAND TERROR drifted in near the sixteenth-pole and lacked the needed kick late while well clear for the show. DARE TO LIVE bumped with SCOTCHIRISH at the start then steadied, moved out while off the pace, raced with his head high in the air, moved up near the half-mile pole, vied three wide while still with his head high in the air on the turn, drifted four wide into the stretch and tired. DADE CITY came away in good order from the outside post, was hustled to the lead, dropped to the inside near the half-mile pole, vied inside while hard ridden on the turn and stopped.
