HARMONIZER settled on the outside, went three wide on the turn, was asked to pursue the leader near the five-sixteenths pole, rallied into the stretch, closed well to gain a short lead passing the furlong marker, battled with D'BIGCAT into the final sixteenth then edged clear under good handling. D'BIGCAT was asked just a bit from the gate, easily took the lead, set the pace with a clear advantage, controlled the tempo while inside on the turn, was set down in upper stretch, fought back a bit when headed passing the furlong marker, battled with the winner into the final sixteenth and was outfinished while able to save a share of the place. IN JUST WE TRUST broke about two lengths slow, moved up on the inside, settled near the rail, raced under light urging while inside on the turn, moved off the rail coming to the quarter-pole, was put to a drive in upper stretch, moved out some while under left hand urging near the furlong marker and finished willingly to get a share of second. FASTUS CACTUS lugged out soon after the start, was taken in hand, continued to lug out on the backstretch, went five to six wide while still getting out on the turn, made a brief surge at the lead outside the five-sixteenths pole, continued wide into stretch then gave way while continuing to lug out. GOOD KARMA came away in good order, angled in at the back of the field, saved ground on the turn and failed to threaten. SPLENDID BEHAVIOR moved in near the five-eighths pole, settled off the pace, was urged along while two then three wide on the turn and tired. SPRING ELUSION settled while off the inside, went two to three wide on the turn and faltered.
