Footnotes

FIDDLERS PATRIOT broke alertly from the outside post, was very quick and set the pace, dictated terms while a bit off the rail on the turn, tightened it up on GOODANDACCEPTABLE coming to the quarter-pole, powered clear when shaken up in upper stretch and drew off under an energetic hand ride on his way to a new course record. GOODANDACCEPTABLE showed good early speed, was eased back behind FIDDLERS PATRIOT to avoid an inside duel, moved up within three-quarters of that rival while inside on the turn, checked sharply along the hedge passing the quarter-pole, regained momentum in upper stretch and narrowly beat STRONG IMPACT for the place. STRONG IMPACT raced just off the pace while urged along, was taken up a bit near the seven-sixteenths pole and dropped back a touch, shifted four wide midway through the turn, chased four wide into the stretch and narrowly missed the place. CHERNOBYL'S HERO bumped lightly with EXTRA ZIP at the start, settled towards the rear, went three wide on the turn, was roused nearing the quarter-pole, moved out in upper stretch and improved position. CITIFEST was urged along early then taken in hand near the half-mile pole, raced off the rail while under some urging on the turn and failed to rally. EXTRA ZIP bumped lightly with CHERNOBYL'S HERO at the start, settled near the back, saved ground on the turn and failed to threaten. MIGHTY TUFF moved up between rivals after a furlong, raced three wide while under restraint on the turn, was asked for run outside the quarter-pole and came up empty. MOR CHANCES bobbled at the start, was ridden along towards the outside, raced five wide

while hard ridden on the turn and failed to respond. MUSTANG ISLAND was urged along in the middle of the field while on the outside, raced four then five wide while hard ridden on the turn and faded. VITAL ARGUMENT immediately dropped back at the start, raced off the rail on the turn and showed little then went wrong near the wire and was vanned off after the race. Following the race, the rider of GOODANDACCEPTABLE lodged an objection against the rider of FIDDLERS PATRIOT for interference near the quarter-pole. After the stewards' review, there was no change made to the order of finish. (Rail at Hedge)
