ROYAL RHIANNON moved to the lead inside the three-quarter pole, set the pace through quick fractions, vied off the rail on the turn, was joined by GLORIOUS VIEW near the five-sixteenths pole, came under a left-handed whip in upper stretch, fought on even terms with the aforementioned rival into the final furlong then edged clear strong handling. GLORIOUS VIEW came away well and showed in front early, relinquished the lead inside the three-quarter pole, stalked on the outside, ranged up while three wide on the turn, drew on even terms with ROYAL RHIANNON passing the five-sixteenths, was asked at the top of the stretch, came under a right-handed whip near the three-sixteenths pole, battled into the final furlong and was outfinished while clear for the place. FREE AS A BIRD settled towards the rear, moved up with a half-mile to run, raced in hand leaving the backstretch, continued in hand while behind GLORIOUS VIEW early on the turn, was asked then driven three wide near the five-sixteenths, loomed a danger passing the quarter-pole, chased under the whip in upper stretch and weakened while able to get the show. COLONIAL EMPRESS was urged along while just off the pace, chased inside early on the turn then came off the rail, pursued the joint leaders into the stretch and tired. VILLANESCA broke a bit slow, was ridden along at the rear while on the outside, passed a couple of rivals while three to four wide on the turn, drifted in nearing the three-sixteenths pole and failed to threaten. OTTAVIANO was urged along on the outside, chased three to four wide on the turn, dropped to one off the rail nearing the quarter-pole and came up empty. RUN FOR RICHES was urged along while off the pace, dropped back while three wide early on the turn, drifted five wide near the three-eighths pole, dropped to four wide shortly thereafter and failed to respond. AWLEYAA was ridden along towards the back, dropped to the inside on the turn and faltered.
