Footnotes

SIDEARM bumped with an opponent at the start, was well placed just off the pace while under some urging, went three then four wide on the turn, chased under a left-handed whip in upper stretch, took the lead entering the final furlong and drew clear under continued left-hand urging. SIDEWAYS VISION chased the pace on the inside, came off the rail entering the turn, continued to chase the vanguard, moved out under a drive in upper stretch, pursued the winner in the final furlong and lacked the needed kick while up for the place. WAKE UP IN MALIBU bumped with a rival at the start then was hustled, disputed the pace on the outside of a foe while getting some pressure from another opponent to his outside, vied off the rail on the turn, was asked while in front and near the rail turning into the stretch, came under a right-handed whip, shied out a couple of paths at the furlong marker, lost the lead at that point and was switched to a left-handed whip, fought on with the winner, switched back to a right-handed whip at the sixteenth-pole and weakened while able to get the show. GINO AND THE JETS pressed the pace on the outside, vied three wide on the turn, chased under a right-handed whip in upper stretch, dropped to the inside near the sixteenth-pole and tired. BLUE CHIPS ONLY was reluctant to load, chased the pace, dropped back between rivals near the half-mile pole, was hard ridden while off the rail on the turn and came up empty. DREAM THEORY was off slow then very sluggish into stride, raced well behind the rest of the field and never reached contention. MICKEY DEE was restless in the gate, charged the front just prior to the start but broke relatively with the field, was urged along while off the pace, angled in outside the half-mile pole, went three wide early on the turn then dropped closer to the inside and showed little. SOUNDS OF SARATOGA was hustled from the start, disputed the pace on the inside, dropped out before the five-sixteenths pole and stopped.
