BERNIE THE MAESTRO away in good order, quickly established control, took up residence at a slight distance from off the rail, picked up the tempo noticeably after throwing down a rather pedestrian opening split, had the primary pursuer fall back abruptly after taking a bad step at the top of the bend, remained on hold until the commencement of the stretch, responded positively once given his cue, fending off the lone potential stretch threat, driving. CAIXA ELETRONICA put to some hand urging nearly from the get-go, sat forwardly placed during the initial stages, needed stronger encouragement to keep within range as the leader headed for the turn, got angled out leaving the midway point on the turn, proved no match. WHERE'S DANNY (IRE) off the inside throughout, moved briefly into the three path eluding the stricken foe past the seven-sixteenths marker, re tucked into the two path once safely by, was under a full drive entering the lane, made no headway. MAUI MARK bobbed at the start, was maneuvered into the three path and safely around a rival in distress midway on the turn, remained three wide the rest of the way to the quarter pole, tired. SAGINAW assumed a forward position shortly after the start, patiently stalked the winner perched to that opponent's outside, took up a bad step in the vicinity of the seven-sixteenths pole, losing his action instantly, was pulled up and subsequently vanned off.
