FANCY BOSS reared up during the first attempt getting loaded into the gate, needed more than usual effort thereafter before finally placed into her stall, proceeded to break without apparent mishap, assumed a forward position shortly after the start, was three wide entering the turn, displaced both MICHONNE and FREUD'S SUNSET to take over, tucking into the two path once sufficiently clear of the latter, extended the lead the rest of the way around the bend, needing no encouragement from the pilot, entered the stretch and was given her encouragement, responded to the calling, emerging from the furlong grounds holding her biggest advantage, maintained the majority of it, crossing the wire still kept to a hand ride. AESTHETIQUE got away behind the others, ducking out greenly reacting to some pressure originating to her inside from FREUD'S SUNSET, raced from off the inside, got taken outward the same time INSTRUMENTAL was on the move off the rail herself, winding up in the four path near the five-sixteenths pole, entered the stretch slightly wider and was set down, drifted in after a couple of light right handed shots racing through the furlong grounds, held a fairly straight course thereafter and rallied willingly to procure the place. INSTRUMENTAL was rank on the bit and along the inside route heading for the end of the backstretch, squeezed her way into the two path and split rivals coming to the five-sixteenths marker, commenced the stretch three wide and under encouragement, got outfinished. UNDER SCRUTINY carried out slightly at the start, was quickly guided over to the rail, slipped towards the two path a few strides before reaching the quarter pole, entered the stretch and was called upon, lacked a solid closing response. BACKSTRETCH LADY three wide at the five-sixteenths pole, had no rally. PLEASE NO EMAILS tracked the front runners from the rail and faltered. FREUD'S SUNSET hard to load, broke well, sat forwardly placed from the two path to the end of the bend, gave way. MICHONNE vied for the lead from the inside, head tilted a bit to the left responded to pressure being applied by the pilot on that side, offered little resistance being replaced in front by the winner shortly after departing the backstretch, got out a few strides later, swung four wide into the lane, folded.
