CASHIER'S DREAM quickly showed in front, set the pace while in hand, drew away when asked for run and was ridden out to the wire. SMOK'N FROLIC was unhurried early, rallied three wide approaching the stretch, could not get to the winner but was clearly best of the others. MAGIC STORM was hustled along early, put in a run along the inside on the turn and had nothing left for the drive. PIECEOFPERFECTION was outrun early, raced three wide and had no response when roused. SPIRIT AND SOUL was hustled along inside and tired in the stretch. AL MAX DINER chased outside and tired after a half mile. WIN'S FAIR LADY tired badly, was eased in the stretch and was vanned off.
