Footnotes

FEBRUARY STORM forced the early pace from outside, moved to the front on the far turn, dug in when challenged in upper stretch, battled into midstretch then edged clear under steady urging. CHARIOTEER settled just off the early pace, rallied three wide to challenge on the turn, fought heads apart into midstretch, but couldn't stay with the winner through the final eighth. GASPERILLO DAZE trailed while racing far back for five furlongs, gained along the inside on the turn, swung wide in upper stretch then rallied belatedly in the middle of the track. BOUND BY HONOUR was in a bit tight at the start, raced in the middle of the pack for a half, made a run five wide to threaten entering the stretch then flattened out. PERSONAL REWARD was pinched back at the start, raced well back while five wide to the turn then lacked a strong closing bid. MOSAYTER outrun early after breaking poorly, saved ground to the turn, was blocked behind a wall of horses at the top of the stretch, altered course to the middle of the track in upper stretch, moved back to the inside in midstretch then closed late along the rail. BALLET CRITIC raced between horses to the turn and lacked a strong closing bid. MORE SPECIFIC (GB) raced up close along the inside for five furlongs and faded. PLAY IT OUT was used up setting the early pace.
