CRITICAL CAT rushed up along the inside to gain the early advantage, opened a clear lead along the backstretch, set the pace along the inside to the turn, dug in when challenged in upper stretch, fought gamely into deep stretch then was fully extended to hold off the runner-up in the final strides. WINLOCS GLORY DAYS was reserved for a half, moved up along the rail nearing the far turn, angled between horses while continuing her run entering the stretch then closed late outside the winner but could not get up. FRANSCAT stalked the pace from outside along the backstretch, rallied three wide to challenge leaving the turn but couldn't sustain her bid. HIGH SPEED ACCESS raced in the middle of the pack while in hand along the backstretch, steadied between horses on the far turn, raced within striking distance along the inside entering the stretch and rallied mildly. WHATSMINEISYOURS raced well back for six furlongs, advanced four wide leaving the turn then failed to threaten while improving her position. EPICA raced just off the early pace between horses, bumped with BUFF 'N POLISH nearing the far turn, swung four wide while gaining on the turn then flattened out. CRIMSON was reserved for six furlongs while saving ground then lacked the needed response when called upon. TIGI taken in hand early, never reached contention while saving ground. BUFF 'N POLISH pressed the pace from outside for a half, steadied sharply on the far turn and was never close thereafter. DANCING RASHA fractious in the gate prior to the start, was never a factor.
