KEY DEPUTY steadied slightly after bumping with MORNING FEVER in the early stages, rushed up to contest the pace along the backstretch, took charge in upper stretch, opened a clear advantage when roused in midstretch then drew off while being ridden out. LYDGATE bumped at the start, outsprinted rivals for the early advantage, set the pace while being pressured by the winner for a half, relinquished the lead in upper stretch then held well to best the others. SAINTS N' SINNERS was outrun for a half, circled six wide into the stretch and rallied belatedly in the middle of the track. DEPUTY DIRECTOR raced four wide to the turn then improved his position with a mild late rally. SULEIMAN raced in the middle of the pack while saving ground to the top of the stretch and lacked a strong closing bid. THIRDDOWN CALL chased the leaders while three wide to the turn and weakened. MAKARUMBA bumped at the start, trailed to the turn, steadied and altered course to the outside in upper stretch then drifted out while gaining some ground in the late stages. MORNING FEVER bumped with the winner soon after the start, saved ground while just off the pace for a half then lacked a strong closing bid. ALTON BAY was outrun for a half then failed to threaten while being carried out in the late stages. BLAZING SONG raced within striking distance while five wide for a half and faltered. SILVER SHIELD was never a factor. GRAND SCAM raced six wide to the top of the stretch then ducked out while well back in the stretch.
